Whilst the colloquium is not limited to members of the participating sections, it will be of particular interest to them. The sections covered are PBSS (Pensions and Social Security), IAAHS (Health), IAALS (Life) and ASTIN (Non-life), as well as IACA (consulting). On the pension side, one can look forward to presentations on investment frameworks, pension fund design and funding, longevity risk and risk management, to name but a few. Looking at life insurance, look forward to topics covering artificial intelligence and machine learning, stochastic modelling, IFRS17 (nobody should miss this one!), professionalism and ethical issues (never too old to learn!) as well as dynamic risk management.

Moving on to ASTIN, we have become accustomed to papers of high quality, and this colloquium will be no difference. A large number of papers will be presented, so you can choose to attend any of your choice – there will be something of interest at any given time. And last, but by no means least, health

will cover topics such as the role of the actuary in health care, anti-selection, impact of improved lifestyles and many more.

Each section is spread over 3 days, of which one day will have more of a South African flavour (coinciding with the local practice area seminars), whilst the other 2 days will have more of an international flavour (although all days would be of interest to actuaries both locally and abroad).

The Colloquium gives South African delegates the opportunity to be exposed to developments abroad, at a fraction of the cost that they will have to pay for an international event. At the same time, given the favourable exchange rates, it gives international delegates the opportunity to attend a world class event in a very popular tourist destination at very reasonable cost.

We have also confirmed the participation of well-known and exciting keynote speakers, which will add further to the value and excitement of the Colloquium.
